The first restaurant opened in Las Vegas on Tuesday, October 16. The second restaurant will open in Henderson at 171 N. Gibson Road on Wednesday, November 7 at 5:00 a.m. This spring Dunkin' Donuts announced plans to bring its renowned coffee, beverages and bakery items to the Las Vegas market with approximately 62 restaurants over the next several years. Las Vegas is part of an aggressive national growth strategy, as the company is expanding in existing markets while entering new markets throughout the country, with plans to ultimately triple the number of Dunkin' Donuts stores in the United States to 15,000 by 2020.
